

PANS working meeting in Louvain-la-Neuve friday April 23, 1999

Present: M.Bex, J.Deutsch, G.Edelheit, F.Ingebretsen, S.Koerner, A.Pascolini, A.Shotter and A.van de Woude.

- 1 We plan to submit THREE EC-requests for June 2: a support for our general PANS-initiative (which could help out also the book-project), a support for our WEB-project and the support to exhibitions in the frame of the European Science and Technology Week.

1.1 It was suggested to request 165 KEUR in total spread over three years for coordination-meetings, cross-fertilization, outside experts, etc. This includes travelling funds for PANS members to participate in the workshops.

It was suggested to have the following "principal-contractors" NuPECC (A.Shotter), EPS(A.van de Woude), INFN (A.Pascolini), HMI (W.van Oertzen, Open University (R.MacIntosh) and UCL (J.Deutsch), who would act as coordinator. (If the request is successful, JD intends to hand over this charge in a year or so to another colleague.) All participants to PANS will be duly listed in the request.

The draft of the request will be circulated within PANS by May 10 and finalized by May 17. The A3 administrative forms should also be ready by this date. Expert advise will be sought on the draft.

1.2 The WEB-project will make a request of a total of 290 KEUR over two (three ?) years. The principal contractors will be GANIL (M.Bex), GSI (KD Gross) and HMI (W.van Oertzen) who will act as the co-ordinator. The other members of the working group will be listed in the request. It would be nice to have the final draft of this proposal also be ready by May 10 to submit it to outside experts. The A3 forms (Administrative informations) should also be ready by this date. 1.3 The Exhibition-group will work out a request of parallel exhibitions in THREE of the seven cultural capitals of Europe. Probably one in Germany and one in France. The collaboration of the NuPECC and EPS/NPB boards is important to finalize the project. The requested money is 200 KEUR for the three exhibitions. It will not be stated in the request, but this is expected to be also seed for our future exhibition-plans. The suggested principal contractors are: NuPECC (S.Gales), EPS(J.Deutsch), IN2P3 (G.Edelheit), GSI (KD Gross) and INFN (A.Pascolini) who will act as the co-ordinator. It would be nice to have the final draft of this proposal ready by May 10 to submit it to outside experts.

- 1.4 Alan Sh. briefly reported on another request presented outside of the Public Awareness chapter to prepare a booklet on Nuclear Physics targeted on fellow-scientists as a follow-up of the more specialized NuPECC-booklet.
- 2 A discussion on the PANS-logo allowed the sparking of some new ideas. Monique Bex will circulate their results in due time.
 - 3 Briding funds: there are 25.5 KEUR readily available or promised with in-kind contributions from GSI (6 month salary of the WEB post-doc), KVI (Adriaan's PANS expenses) and CRC/LLN (JD's PANS-expenses). Still pending: CEA,Legnaro and Catania. We committed to the book-project afirst contribution of 15 KEUR.
 - 4 Search for long-term funds.
This is still in (slow) progress.
